Method

- **Method 1:** 100% of the disbursement is distributed on identified targets
- **Method 2:** Each SDG target assessed individually:
 - 100% - Principal objective
 - 75% - Very important objective
 - 50% - Important objective
 - 25 % - Relevant objective

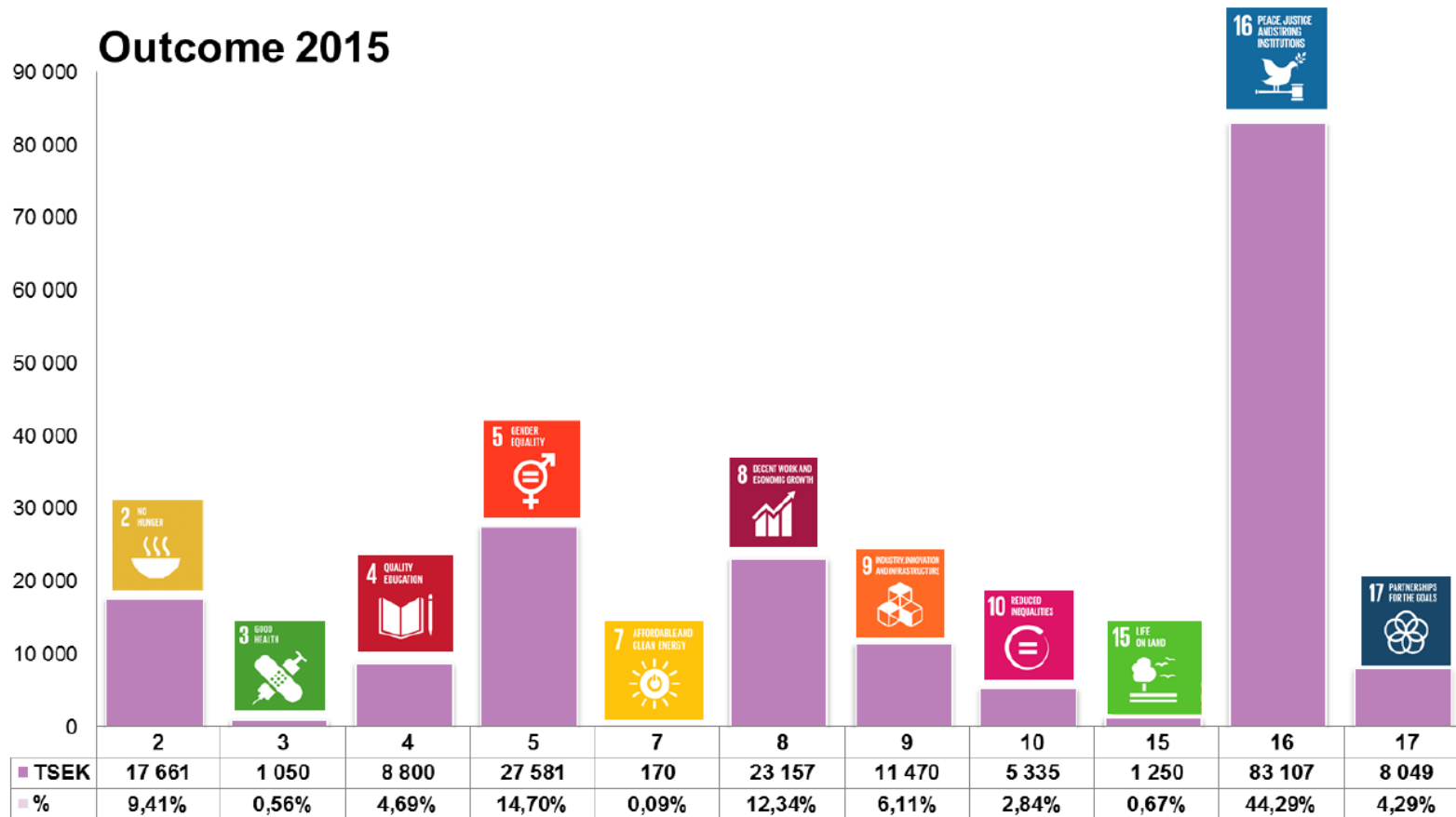


Illustration of results - Colombia

Outcome 2015

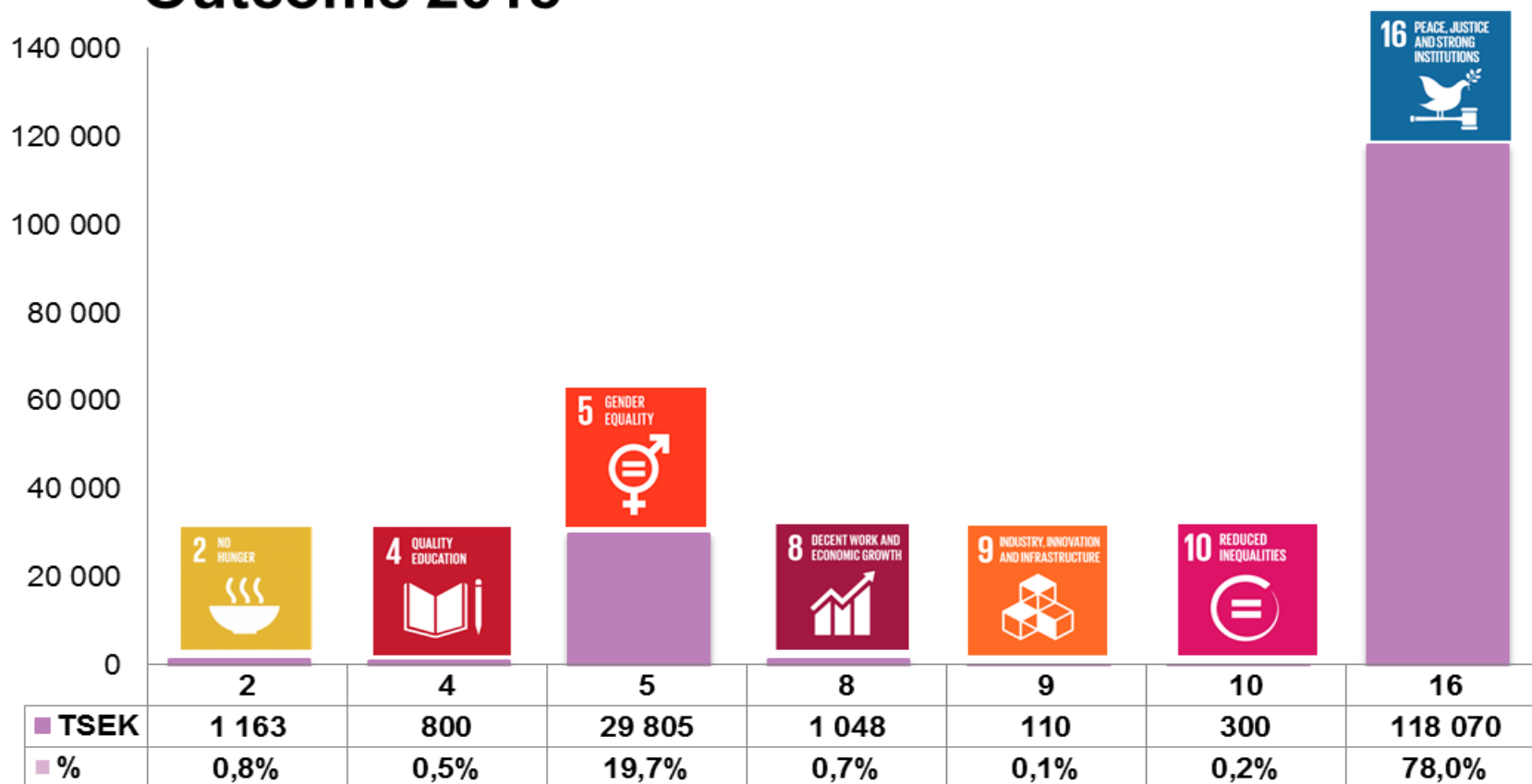
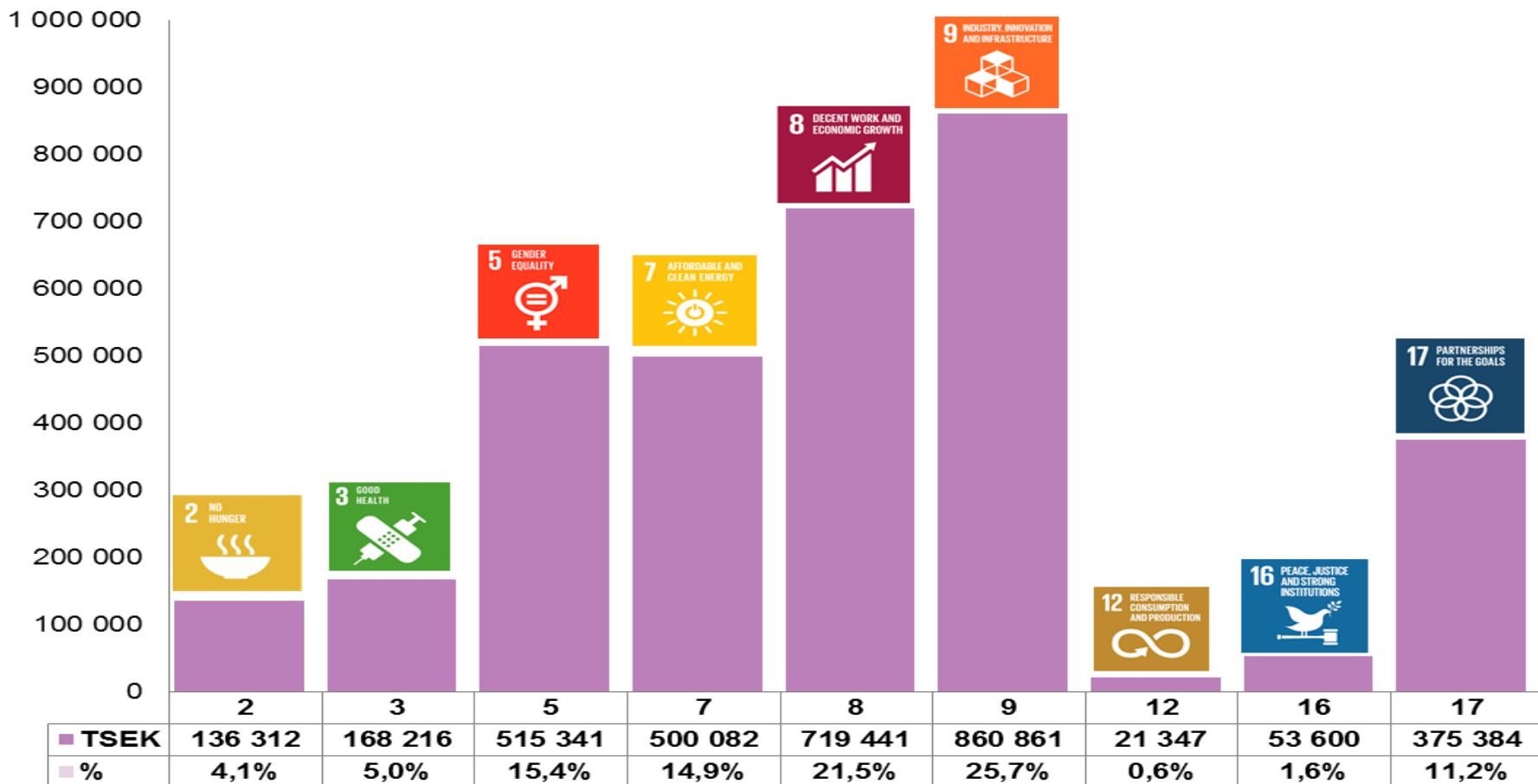


Illustration of results - Guarantees
